The Request for Qualification shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked: "DO NOT OPEN: Navajo Generating Station Redevelopment Plan". Firms claiming Priority 1 or Priority 2 shall label their proposal on the envelope or in the subject line. The Cost Proposal shall be provided in a separate envelope marked: "DO NOT OPEN: Cost – Navajo Generating Station Redevelopment Plan" and must be received no later than Friday, June 28, until 3:00 PM local time, after which time the RFQ will be received and opened at a later time.

The selection of the qualified firm will be made in accordance with the Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act, and the selected firm shall comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations of the Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act, N.N.C. Title 5, Chapter 2, Section 201, et. Seq., where applicable.

Each firm shall submit three (3) bound and sealed, one original and two copies of their RFQ. Telefaxed copies will not be accepted. RFQ's received after the designated time and date will be returned unopened. Failing to provide statements or documents required by the Request for Qualifications will be deemed non-responsive.

The Division of Economic Development reserves the right to reject any and all RFQ's and to waive any informality whenever such rejection or waiver is deemed in the best interest of the Navajo Nation.
